



What do I need to bring?

Your room comes with almost everything you'll need, check out the **'What's Included'** section on each room type description for full details. This page will guide you on what additional items you need to bring, what not to bring and what we recommend you buy locally.

Bring

- iQ paperwork (iQ Edinburgh only)
- Bedding including Duvet, Pillows & Sheets
- Computer or Laptop
- **Studios only** - Basic kitchen bits & pieces (i.e. plates, cutlery, kettle etc.)*
- Towels
- Coat Hangers
- Toiletries
- Toilet Paper
- TV for your room if required (max. 21", not wall hung) Don't forget you can also get IPTV

Don't Bring

- Fridge including mini-fridge
- Car (unless you have allocated parking)
- Candles
- Portable heaters
- **Shared flats** - Kitchen bits* & pieces - see below

Best to buy locally

- **Shared flat** - Kitchen bits & pieces. It is better to meet up with your flatmates and purchase these items together otherwise you will end up with several sets of everything.*
- Food and drink

*Induction Compatible Pots & Pans

Please note that you may have an induction hob in your kitchen. In order for your hob to operate efficiently the correct cooking pans must be used. These pans must be made from: steel, stainless steel, enamel steel or cast iron. For maximum efficiency, ensure that the pan is flat as possible at the base.
